There are four different contests. They are open to any student attending any of the Edgewood ISD High Schools. Students may enter multiple contests. (As long as they submit a completed packet for each contest)

Each contest winner will be awarded \$1000.00 and the runner-up will be awarded \$500.00 per contest. The Winner will have the opportunity to advance to the next level to compete for more scholarship money.

2024-2025 Contest Rules

What are the advantages and disadvantages of Artificial Intelligence, "A.I."

1. Contest Rules

- a. Contestants shall be evaluated on a 750 to 1000 word essay, their biographical information statement, community service, experience/participation leadership information, three letters of recommendation, their high school grade point average and a personal interview.
- b. The following criteria shall be used for judging the contestant:
 - i. Fifteen percent (15%) 750-1000 word essay on: What are the advantages and disadvantages of Artificial Intelligence, "A.I."

We have all heard the talk about AI, both the good and the bad. Regardless of what you think about the risks of using AI, it is here to stay. Businesses of all sizes have found great benefits from using AI, and consumers around the world use it in their daily lives. But even people who are excited about AI ask the question: What are the real advantages and disadvantages of using it?

In this essay contestants are asked to discuss the major benefits and drawbacks of adopting AI, both in everyday life and in business. Also, discuss how it has affected you, especially as it pertains to social media. The essay must be well organized, have good vocabulary and conform to required length.

- ii. Five percent (5%) Grade point average from school transcript.
- iii. **Fifteen percent (15%)** Three (3) letters of recommendation.
- iv. **Thirty-five percent** (35%) Biographical information statement and resume to include community service, leadership experience/participation information
- v. **Thirty percent** (30%) Personal interview. The personal interview may include matters on current local, state, national or worldwide events.

- c. Incomplete submissions will result in score deductions.
- d. Judges shall be persons who are knowledgeable about community service and high school level leadership.
- e. All contests shall be conducted in the English language.
- f. Order of appearance before the judging panel will be determined in advance at the direction of the Chair.
- g. Contestants will not give any self-introduction but shall state their name and the interview shall proceed.

2. Awards

- a. The 1st place winner will win a \$1,000.00 scholarship.
- b. The 2nd place winner will win a \$ 500.00 scholarship.
- c. To collect the scholarship award, the Contestant must complete the following process:
 - i. Contestant winner or runners-up must complete the Scholarship Request Form along with proof of registration information from a university, college, junior college or vocational school.
 - ii. The information should be sent to the Club Treasurer, along with any supplemental information needed by the institution (i.e. scholarship forms, etc.). Send request for payment to:

- d. Payment will be made directly to the recipient.
- e. The scholarship awards must be collected no later than two years following the recipient's graduation from High School.

3. Rules of Eligibility for Contestants

- a. A school may may sponsor <u>any number of contestant</u> in each contest by submitting a completed entry application (containing all requested signatures), associated documents, and the entry fee to the Contest Chairperson prior to the entry deadline.
- b. A false statement on the entry application, associated document or violation of contest rules will cause disqualification of the Contestant.

- c. Each contestant must be or have been a regularly enrolled student in a public high school or comparable educational program, located in Texas.
- d. Each contestant must be a junior or senior at the time of the contest.

4. Responsibilities of Contestant

- a. Each Contestant shall be required to submit the following to his or her sponsoring Lions Club and/or District.
 - i. **Four (4) typed copies** of the State Contest Application (mandatory to be completed online and copied; no handwritten applications will be accepted).
 - ii. **Two (2)** high quality wallet/passport size photographs (such as current school picture) that are of the head-and-shoulders, glossy and in color. No paper copies of photos will be accepted. Photos not meeting this requirement will not be included in contest souvenir booklet.
 - iii. **Four (4) typed double spaced copies** of your 750 to 1000 word essay with word count on last page of essay. Essay changes are not permitted once received by State Contest Coordinator.
 - iv. **Four (4) typed copies** of your biographical information statement and your resume' to include community service, leadership experience/participation experience.
 - v. **Four (4) copies** of the three (3) letters of recommendation.
 - vi. One (1) certified high school transcript, plus three (3) copies.
- b. The winning contestant must agree to be available at the District Opportunities for Youth Contest,

Orientation will be held Saturday, March 22, 2025 and the Contest will be held on Saturday, March 29, 2025, at times set forth by the District Contest Chair.

Online Contest: Contestants must be able to participate in orientation and the contest using online live audio and video communication tools. **Zoom** video conferencing will be used for the contest.

Prior to orientation and the contest, contestants, parents and sponsoring Lions Club contacts will be provided with instructions for the online contest.
